Aldine/Spring ISD Stadium Policies

- <u>Current Aldine ISD and UIL Rules will be enforced at all times.</u> <u>State Laws and School Policies will be in effect concerning alcoholic beverages, controlled substances, weapons, and distribution of any type of literature.</u>
- Spectators are not allowed on the field before or after the game. Only students of school organized and approved activities will be allowed on the field.
- Only drill team, band students, or cheerleaders, in uniform, mayform victory lines on the playing field.
- Air Horns, Bells, and other mechanical/electronic noisemakers are prohibited in ALL district athletic contests.
- Glass bottles or glass containers are prohibited in the complex.


Food, drinks, tobacco, gum and seeds of any type are prohibitedin the field area.

- The use of confetti is prohibited in the stadium. No wrapping ofthe goal posts is permitted.
- Balloons may not be brought into the stadium. Items such as skateboards, scooters, Frisbees, and balls are not permitted in the stadium.
- Live animal mascots are not allowed in the stadium. Mascots, signs, etc. may be displayed on respective sidelines.
- No band, drill team, cheerleaders, or photographers may encroach upon the restraining lines (dotted lines) or the bench area (25-yard line to 25-yard line) during the course of the game.
- Spirit Signs- signs are allowed on the top fence of each side stands and along walkway rails on each side. All signs should beremoved at the conclusion of the contest.
- All people on the sidelines outside of bench are should have a sideline pass. No one is allowed to stand, photograph, or film from the end zone of the area of the field without authorization.
- Only authorized personnel will be allowed on the field or in theteam area before the game, at half-time, or after the game.
- Run through signs may not be placed on the field if it has been raining and acrylic type paint has been used.
- The only groups permitted to sell products at the stadium are groups that have been approved by the Athletic Department.
- <u>The use of Tobacco products/E-Cigarettes or any other type of smoking device is prohibited on the property of ALL Athletic Facilities in Aldine ISD.</u>
- <u>TICKET GATE</u>- Ticket Gates will open one (1) hour before thegame. No ticket refunds will be given! No re-entry is allowed. Spectators must enter on the side in which they want to view thecontest. Crossing sides is NOT permitted.
- <u>PASSES</u>- May enter on the HOME/VISITOR Side. Make sure tohave proper passes that have been agreed upon by the DEC Committee in District 14-6A. (SEE ATTACHMENT for Passes Accepted)
- <u>TEAM GATES</u>- Gates will open two hours before game time. The Home and Visiting teams will enter on the North end of the stadiumand use the dressing rooms designated for their school.
- <u>PARKING</u>- All band and drill team buses will be parked at the South end of the stadium enter as a group through the "HOME" ticket gate. (Cypresswood Dr.)
- <u>PARKING (Cont.)</u> Team buses and officials will park on theNorth end of the stadium and enter through the gate by the locker rooms.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

- All school photographers must have a school media pass to take pictures on the field. *This pass is NOT good for free entrance to the game!*
- Each team and district video personnel should be limited to four (4) people.
